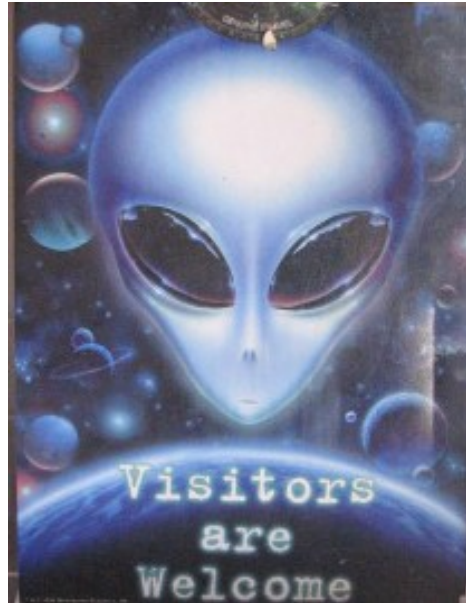

Rev. George Brooks

The above image appeared on a wall in the Cottonwood Hotel in 1996.

There is a unique resemblance to Rev. George Brooks, 1920's spiritualist, lecturer and renown psychic. While he predicted Cottonwood was about to have their biggest catastrophe ever, Rev. Brooks failed to save himself while he burned to death in the Cottonwood Hotel during Cottonwood's 1925 fire. The fire destroyed buildings and homes on the whole west side of town a day after his prediction. He was the only fatality. It was later believed that Mr. Brooks walked the floors of the upstairs hallway looking for a way out. Owner of the Cottonwood Hotel since 1996, Karen Leff, with assisted help, released Mr. Brooks ties to the earth plane and guided him to the white light.
